INTRODUCING: Blends

LANGUAGE AND READING:

For the next 2 weeks, the children will learn about winter and hibernation. We will learn which animals hibernate and all things that happen in the season of winter.

The children will continue to learn to read and spell CVC words. We will also reinforce the phonetic sounds for all of our letters. Blends will be introduced.

MATH AND SCIENCE CONCEPT:

We will discuss the season change and the differences we notice. In science, we will have a melting experiment.

In math, the children will learn to count by 2's. We will practice addition and introduce subtraction.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

As always, we will work on readiness papers. We will practice writing by slowing down and taking our time. The children are doing a great job with coloring in the lines. We have a hibernation craft and a melted snowman craft to create!
