INTRODUCING: Simple subtraction
Blends
Telling time by the half hour

LANGUAGE AND READING:

The children are going to learn all about snow and snow birds. We will discuss penguins, cardinals and snow owls to name a few. We will also discuss where all the other birds went to this winter.

We will continue to practice reading our Guided Reading stories and CVC words. We encourage using a finger under each word to read and sound out. We will introduce blends. (words starting with bl, cl, fl, gl, st, br, tw, etc.) Lastly, we will work on finding the missing vowel with CVC words.

MATH AND SCIENCE CONCEPT:

We will use cubes to introduce simple subtraction. This is a fun, visual way of teaching. We will also continue telling time by the hour and introduce the half hour.

During Science, the children will discuss the season of winter and participate in a snow experiment. We may even bring some snow inside for the children to explore.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

During craft time this week, we will create some bird houses and paint some beautiful winter birds.

We will work on writing by spelling CVC words and we will start whole group writing.

We are encouraging the children to take their time and do neat work when it comes to printing and coloring.

PARENT NOTES:

Please bring in winter gear. We will go outside and play in the snow if the weather permits.

We will discuss Dr. Martin Luther King Day on Monday, January 15.

Kindergarten evaluations will be completed this month.
