Solar System

INTRODUCING: money (penny, nickel, dime, quarter)

LANGUAGE AND READING:

Over the next 2 weeks, the children will be working on building words and building sentences. We will continue with compound words and blends.

We will discuss the Solar System and learn the order of the planets. We will also be introduced to many space words such as: atmosphere, gravity and astronaut.

If you have any Solar System books to share, please allow your child to bring them to school.

MATH AND SCIENCE CONCEPT:

We have a graphing project on whether or not the Ground Hog will see his shadow. Subtraction and place value will also be done.

The children will be introduced to money and the value of different coins. We will play games and use the money you bring in for activities.

In science, we will have an experiment using milk to create a galaxy. We will also build our very own constellations.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

The children will work on printing their letters and numbers correctly. We will take our time and work on starting from the top. We will start on whole group writing and sentence dictation.

During craft, the children will create and name their own planet. They will also use collage material on the planet Earth!
