Makes Perfect

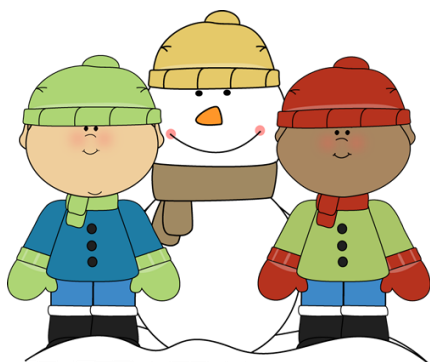
### Expressive Vocabulary:
