Reptiles and Amphibians

INTRODUCING: Story #6—Mother, Father, come, and, see, me, Hop, hop

LANGUAGE:

Snakes, turtles and lizards, oh my! We will discuss reptiles and amphibians this week. We will learn about what they eat, where they live and what they are compared to mammals. If you have any pictures or books of these scaly, slimy creatures, please allow your child to bring them in to school to share. We have a couple fun reptile songs to learn.

We are going to work on Story #6 with the children. They are doing well with their reading stories.

CONCEPT:

The children will continue to master the jobs off the concept shelves. We will add a few new ones. We are going to focus on puzzles this week. We will do a group puzzle and let the children work individually on puzzles.

We are going to try a science experiment with using salt water vs. fresh water.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

The children will enjoy coloring pictures of reptiles and amphibians. Keep a look out for review/readiness papers in your child's folder. We are stressing to the children to take their time on their paperwork. Remember when practicing at home to use uppercase and lowercase letters when practicing your child's first and last name.
