INTRODUCING: Uu & Vv

LANGUAGE AND READING:

We are going to the Farm for the next two weeks! We will listen to many stories to help us learn different parts of a farm. Some of the topics will be the types of animals, what they eat, what farms can grow, sounds you hear and all about what a farm does. We will also learn some fun “farm” songs.

We will add to the ‘A’ is for Amos song with the letters Uu and Vv.

CONCEPT:

We will be busy grouping, sorting, counting and distinguishing farm animals from other animals. The science table will have items to explore and a sensory bin to play in. Some of the materials that we will learn about are wool, corn and feathers.
