Review week. We are going to fine tune everything that we have learned this year.

LANGUAGE AND READING:

During language for the next 2 weeks, we are going to talk about the season of spring and all that goes along with it! We will listen to stories and discuss the observations we see during this time of the year.

During reading, the children will perfect their color sight words. Short and long vowel sounds will be reviewed along with digraphs and blends. The children are doing great with reading strategies such as looking at a picture and knowing what the letter sounds are.

MATH AND SCIENCE CONCEPT:

The boys and girls are doing a great job with simple addition and subtraction. We will continue to practice money and fractions. We will now introduce measuring. We will use nonstandard units such as hands, feet, blocks and paperclips.

Science: We are going to learn about the leprechaun traps that we made and how they work.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

We will have many writing activities about our favorite color in the rainbow and how to trap a leprechaun. We will keep practicing spelling CVC words. Spelling tests will begin. Please practice these words with your child at home. Tests will be on Friday.

For art, we will create a rainbow and leprechaun. For Easter, we will have fun designing Easter eggs.
