Topic: Ocean Animals



**Motor:** As the weather gets warmer, we will have more opportunities to go outside. The beanbag toss will help us review and a new path to follow will include a rocking boat, hula-hoops and the tumbling mat.



Language Arts: Our topic of conversation this week is ocean animals. We have great stories to read, as well as a few songs about our ocean friends. "What's wrong with the picture?" will put some laughter into our days as well. Ms. Kailey will be building words with the children this week along with introducing a new word family -en.



**Concept:** This week Mrs. Christine will teach the children all about life in the ocean. The children will use seashells and mini erasers for counting and patterning. We will begin counting by 2's. this week. "What's Missing?" is a fun game that helps with visual memory skills.



**Craft and Writing:** Our numbers and letters will be reviewed through printing readiness papers. Colors and shapes will be reinforced with a following directions worksheet. The children will be asked to color a certain shape a specific color. Look for an ocean project to come home this week!
