Theme: Reptiles/Amphibians

The children will enjoy these fun weeks, as we learn several different types of reptiles and amphibians. Activities will teach the children the names and characteristics of these animals.

Language Arts:

Our discussion will focus on alligators, snakes, lizards, turtles, frogs, and toads. We will learn the terms lungs and coldblooded. Also, we will discuss how they live and special things about their skin. The children will also be introduced the fable The Hare and The Tortoise. Fiction and non-fiction will be discussed, learning the beginning, middle, and end of a story, and continued work on blend words.
