Craft and Writing

We will continue to review addition and subtractions skills, as well as ordinal numbers and the understanding of different coins. As a fun counting activity, we will learn how to measure using unifix cubes, counters and other objects.

In Science class, the children will label the parts of a bird and go on a bird watch outside.

Language

Throughout the week, we will read books about birds and chicks. We will talk about the biggest bird, the ostrich, and the smallest bird, the hummingbird. The children will learn which animals hatch from eggs and which don't.
