LANGUAGE AND READING:

Bugs, spiders, insects and creepy crawlers are going to be discussed for the next two weeks. We will learn the body parts of insects and how many legs and eyes spiders have. We will read stories and sing some bug songs!

The children are also going to work on nouns, adjectives, blends and digraphs.

MATH AND SCIENCE CONCEPT:

We will work on money, time, fractions and missing number papers during math. We will also pull out our rulers and practice measuring.

During science, the children will get to explore bugs outside with some bug catchers. We will also compare flying insects to non-flying insects.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

This week the children get to create a bug jar and a meadow of ladybugs.

We will write about our favorite insect. We are also going to create our own insect and write about it!

If we have time, we will practice printing as the children “write the room”!
