Topic: Birds

Introductions: Fable #11 – The Grasshopper and the Ants

Moral – We should always make plans for the future.

Language Arts:

Ms. Kailey's topic of discussion is birds this week. She will talk about the different characteristics of birds as well as the different species. We will take a nature walk in our backyard and see what types of birds we can find. The children are working very hard on our Spring songs!

Motor

In Ms. Kailey's Motor class will continue going outdoors. The children will enjoy different variations of the obstacle course using hula hoops, etc. Kicking at a target is sure to improve aim. Group games will be enjoyed during outdoor time.

Concept

The students are ready to begin counting from 1-60. We have been working hard on the concept of odd and even. We began counting backwards from 20 to 1. To reinforce the concept of distance, the class will measure the number of "feet" between two objects. Grab your binoculars...bird watching is on the agenda. Ms. Kailey has a nest that the children can inspect and discuss how the birds created it. We have been counting by 2's and 5's, ask your little one to show you.

Craft and Writing

Ms. Kailey will incorporate our fine feathered friends into our readiness papers. One includes a dot-to-dot bird, another a robin worksheet to color. We will end the week with a bird craft!
