Insects and Creepy Crawlers

LANGUAGE AND READING:

The Itsy Bitsy Spider went up the water spout! The Hungry Caterpillar, The Grouchy Ladybug and The Very Quiet Cricket will be just some of the books we will read as we learn about insects. We will discuss the parts of bugs and sing some buggie songs. Our class will also focus on phonetic sounds. Ask your child what letters say to see if they know!

CONCEPT:

Green ones, yellow ones, spotted and multi-legged bugs! There are so many to sort. The children will show off their skills by sorting them by color, size, type and how many legs they have. We will show the children how to determine the difference of a spider to an insect. We have a bug in a leaf activity to enjoy as well. Lastly, the children will get to go outside and see if they can find any bugs!

We are going to be creative this week during craft and writing as the children make a ladybug and a bumblebee project. We will work on readiness papers and name papers to help with printing. We will have the children practice cutting too.
